## YARN

CYCA #4, Schachen-  
mayr Original  
Favorito or equiva-  
lent (114 yd/104 m /  
50 g; 41% cotton,  
34% acrylic, 25%  
nylon).

## YARN AMOUNTS

White 01, 150 g  
Taupe 10, 200 g  
Mint 72, 50 g

## HOOK

U.S. size H-8 / 5 mm

## NOTIONS

Tapestry needle

## GAUGE


18 sc and 24 rows =  
4 x 4 in / 10 x 10 cm

## Instructions

Work 12 Basic Triangles (see page 8 for pattern and below for color sequence) with an additional rnd as follows:

**Rnd 6:** Ch 3 (= 1 dc), ch 1, \*(4 dc, ch 2, 4 dc) in next ch-sp, ch 1 (4 dc, ch 1) in each of the next 4 ch-spaces; rep from \* once more, (4 dc, ch 2, 4 dc) in next ch-sp, ch 1, (4 dc, ch 1) in each of the next 3 ch-spaces, 3 dc in next ch-sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch.

- Make 6 Triangles with Rnds 1 and 2 worked in Taupe, Rnd 3 in Mint, Rnd 4 in White, and Rnds 5 and 6 in Taupe.
- Make 6 Triangles with Rnds 1 and 2 worked in White, Rnd 3 in Mint, Rnd 4 in Taupe, and Rnds 5 and 6 in White.



Arrange the Triangles as shown in the schematic and sew them together (see page 77), working loosely. Join the ends to form a loop.

## Finishing

The edges are worked in the round.

### Edging

**Rnd 1:** Join Taupe with sl st to a ch-sp at the top of one of the Triangles with Rnd 6 worked in Taupe, ch 4 (= 1 tr), 3 tr in the same ch-sp, ch 1, 4 dc in the corner ch-sp of the next White Triangle, (ch 1, 4 dc, ch 1) in each of the next 5 ch-spaces, ch 1, 4 dc in the end corner of the White Triangle, ch 1, \*4 tr in the top of the next Taupe Triangle, ch 1, 4 dc in the corner ch-sp of the next White Triangle, (ch 1, 4 dc, ch 1) in each of the next 5 ch-spaces, ch 1, 4 dc in the end corner of the White Triangle, ch 1; rep from \* once more, join with sl st in 4th ch.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3 (= 1 dc), (4 dc, ch 1) in each ch-sp around; in the last ch-sp, only work 3 dc, join with sl st in 3rd ch.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 3 (= 1 dc), 3 dc in first ch-sp, 4 dc in each ch-sp around (and do not make a ch-sp between each group of 4 dc), join with sl st in 3rd ch.

Repeat edging on other side of scarf.

Weave in ends, dampen, and dry flat to block.
