

# Artful Brioche [UTE DORNHOF]

## LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY

Easy



## SIZE

**Circumference:** 44 in (112 cm)

**Width:** 16½ in (42 cm)

## MATERIALS

**Yarn:** CYCA #3 (DK/light worsted), Schachenmayr original Extra Merino or equivalent (100% Virgin Wool; 140 yd/138 m / 50 g), Rubin (31), 200 g

**Needles:** U.S. size 11 / 8 mm

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

13 sts and 18 rows in St st with 2 strands of yarn held tog = 4 x 4 in / 10 x 10 cm

Adjust needle size to obtain correct gauge if necessary.



## BRIOCHE STITCH

Worked over an even number of sts.

**Row 1:** Selvage, k1, \*yo, p1, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k1, selvage.

**Row 2:** Selvage, k1, \*yo, p2tog (working next yo and st tog); rep from \* to last 2 sts, k1, selvage.

Rep Row 2 for pattern.

This scarf is worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

## INSTRUCTIONS

With 2 strands of yarn held tog, CO 20 sts. Work in Brioche Stitch until approx. 1 yd (100 cm) of yarn rem and scarf measures approx. 44 in (112 cm). BO all sts, working each yo-st pair tog as 1 st—20 sts.

## FINISHING

Sew the CO and BO edges tog to form a loop. Weave in ends.
